

Highlights of Sri Lanka

Day 01: Arrive Colombo - Negombo (-/-/-)

You will be met on arrival in Colombo and transfer to Negombo where you will check in to your hotel for the night. The rest of the day is free at your leisure.

Day 02: Negombo - Dambulla (B/-/-)

After breakfast, check out of the hotel and embark on a city tour of Negombo. Explore the bustling fish market and wander amongst the fishermen and vendors, before travelling to Negombo Dutch Fort. This historic fortress was built by the Portuguese in the 17th Century, offering stunning views of the surrounding area and a glimpse into the history and culture of Negombo. Depart the city and travel to Sigiriya and the famous Rock Fortress. Climb to the top of the UNESCO World Heritage Listed Site and admire the spectacular view. Continue to Dambulla and check in to your hotel for the next two nights.

Day 03: Dambulla (B/-/-)

The day is free at your leisure, or choose from optional activities* (surcharges apply).

*Optional Activity: Visit the ancient city of Polonnaruwa. Wander through Sri Lanka's ancient capital, amongst the Royal Palace, temples, monasteries, and Buddha statues.

*Optional Activity: Minneriya National Park Safari. Visit the national park as the sun goes down, searching through grassy plains, wetlands, and dense forests for elephants, birdlife, crocodiles, deer, monkeys, and more.

Day 04: Dambulla - Kandy (B/-/-)

Check out from the hotel and visit Dambulla Cave Temple, a World Heritage Listed Site featuring a complex of cave temples filled with religious and artistic artifacts. Continue on your journey to Matale and explore the Spice Garden, walking amongst the abundant herbs and spices. Take a hands on cooking class and learn how to make traditional Sri Lankan roti flatbread. Continue to Kandy and check in to your hotel for the next two nights.

*Optional Activity: Kandy Food Walk. Take a walking tour of the city, visiting the Central Market and sampling local cuisine. Taste tea, local sweets, curries and more.

Day 05: Kandy (B/-/-)

After breakfast, explore the city of Kandy. Explore the iconic Temple of the Tooth Relic, stroll through the lush Royal Botanical Gardens, and take a scenic drive around Kandy Lake. Explore the local marketplace and take in the rich heritage and contemporary charm of the area.

*Optional Activity: Peradeniya Botanical Garden. Explore the gardens carefully curated for the cultivation of a diverse range of species. The gardens are an important place of research for botanists and horticulturists.

In the evening enjoy a Cultural Show with traditional music and drumming, showcasing the rich and vibrant culture of Sri Lanka.







Highlights of Sri Lanka

Day 06: Kandy - Nuwara Eliya (B/-/-)

After breakfast, transfer to Peradeniya railway station for the picturesque ride to Nanu Oya. Wind through verdant tea plantations, dense forests, and mist covered hills on your journey, as you also pass by charming villages and cascading waterfalls. Check in to your hotel in Nuwara Eliya on arrival, then embark on a tour of the city. Explore the manicured tea plantations and visit a tea factory to learn about the tea making process, admire the flowers in Victoria Park, and marvel at the colonial architecture of the city.

*Optional Activity: Grand Hotel High Tea. Indulge in an elegant high tea at the Grand Hotel, nestled amongst the enchanting hills of Sri Lanka.

Day 07: Nuwara Eliya - Tissamaharama (B/-/-)

Check out from Nuwara Eliya and travel to the historic Nine Arch Bridge. This iconic railway bridge was built during the British Colonial era, with its nine stunning arches a testament to engineering ingenuity. Take a short hike through the tea plantations and dense forests for a spectacular view. Continue on your journey to Tissamaharama and check in to the hotel. The rest of the day is free at your leisure.

Day 08: Tissamaharama - Galle (B/-/-)

Today you have an early start, collect a packed breakfast and travel to Yala National Park for a spectacular wildlife adventure by jeep safari. Search for leopards, elephants, sloth bears, crocodiles, and more in the jewel of Sri Lanka. Return to the hotel for a rest before travelling to Galle and visiting Galle Fort. The UNESCO World Heritage Listed Fort is surrounded by the Indian Ocean, and an array of cafes, restaurants, and gift shops housed in beautifully restored Portuguese and Dutch buildings. Check in to your hotel for the next two nights.

Day 09: Galle (B/-/-)

The day is free at your leisure until it is time to embark on an evening walking tour of Galle. Wander along cobblestone streets, admire the architecture, and watch the stunning sunset over the coastline.

Day 10: Galle - Depart Colombo (B/-/-)

The morning is free for you to explore or relax at the hotel before checking out and travelling to Colombo for an evening tour of the city. Visit the Old Parliament Building, Galle Face Green Promenade, and stunning Gangaramaya Temple. Wander through the local markets and immerse yourself in the diverse culture of Colombo.

*Optional Activity: Dinner at Ceylon Curry Club. Treat your tastebuds to an exquisite culinary journey at the Ceylon Curry Club. Indulge in a rich blend of flavours using local spices and ingredients, surrounded by a warm ambiance.
