### Day 1: Arrive Tokyo (-/-/-)

#### Day 1: Arrive Tokyo (-/-/-)

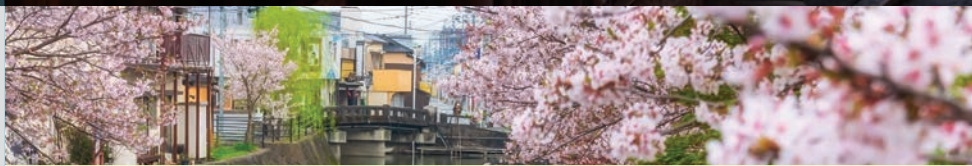

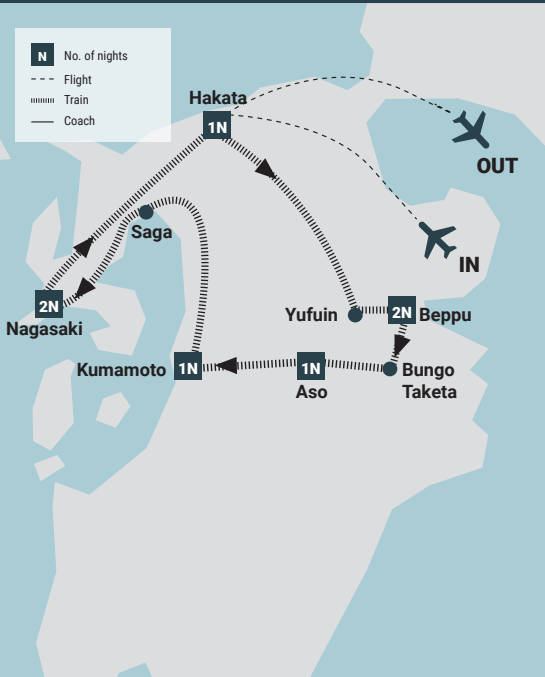

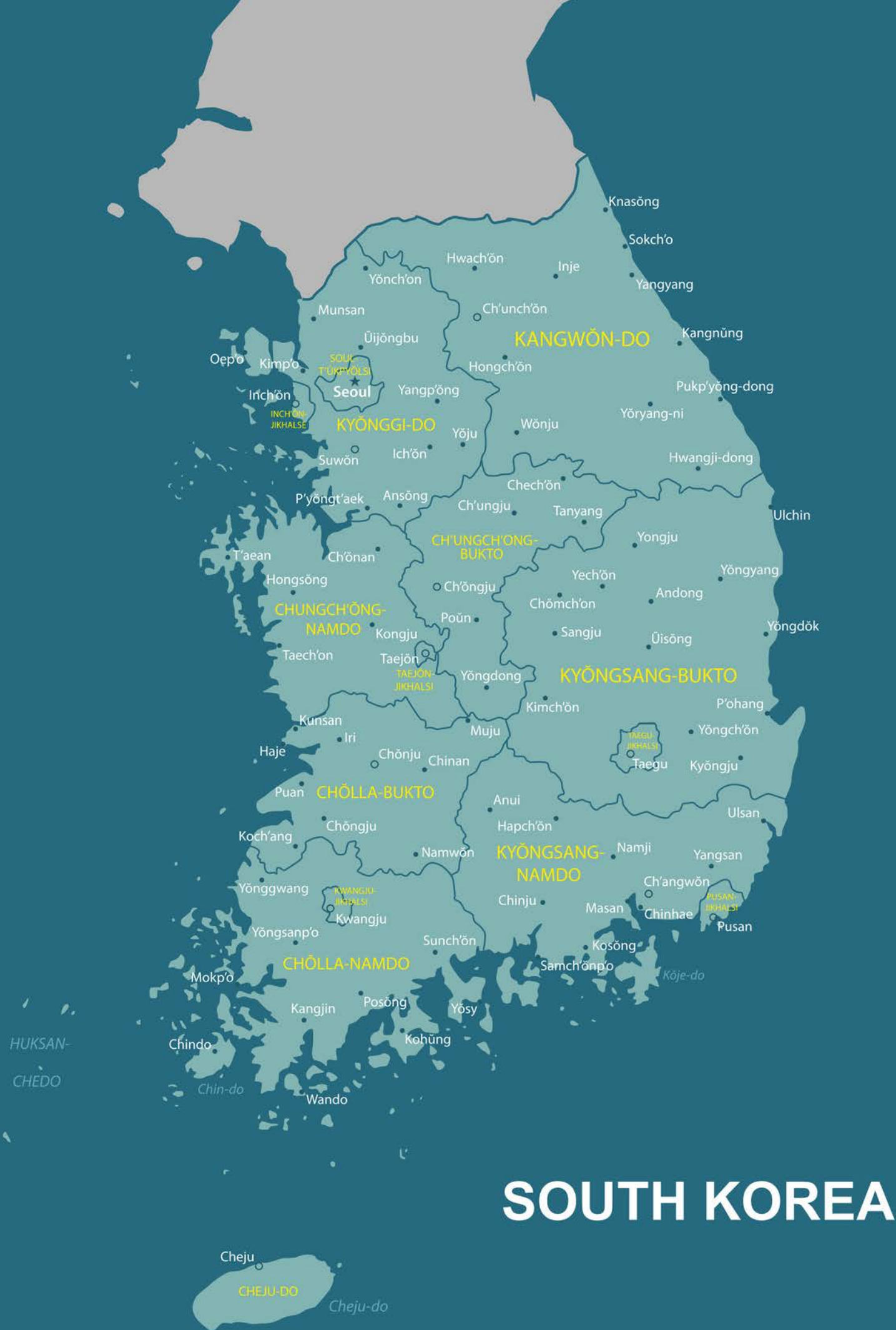
